Are you looking to create your own Internet Business to start getting out of debt or changing your life? We can relate.

If you've never met me or my business partner (and brother) John before, let me tell you a quick story about us so you know where we came from.

My family was in debt for many, many years. My father simply didn't make enough money as a Police Officer to pay the bills. It wasn't until my Dad created his very own Internet Business that he was able to permanently break free of the chains of debt.

The best part of this plan is that you can start making money without spending a dime. Nothing in this manual costs a penny to implement. You'll be able to start killing off your debt with no investment required.

However, investing in high quality private label rights content is a smart move. You can personally write all of the content we discuss, but why do that when someone else has already done the work for you?

It's so much faster and easier to just re-write private label rights content and then break it up into content for your blogs and websites. You'll be able to start earning your investment back much quicker.

You're always either investing time or money...if you have a few bucks to invest in your business (it WILL pay off), you should seriously consider using **Private Label Rights** content.

Just in case you don't know, Private Label Rights content is written content in the form of articles or informational products that you purchase the rights to. Once you purchase the rights to this content, you can use it in literally any way you'd like! You can use it to build websites, create products, or even write your own books.

Don't worry, if you don't completely understand what we mean yet, continue reading. We'll give you tips in this report about using Private Label Rights content the right way.

Here's the really cool part, though.

If you have 5 to 10 hours per week, you'll be able to have a full-fledged blog sending you **\$100-\$300+ checks** every month with only a little bit of effort. And, this amount will continue to go up every single month (automatically) if you follow the steps below properly...

But, if you have 20 hours per week, you'll be able to earn **\$1,000+** checks every month. In other words...the PLR Quick Cash Internet Business model is entirely scalable.

It does take an investment of time...but if you stick with it, you WILL get results. We've seen this time and time again from each of our blogs. They continuously pump out cash for us.

--PLR Quick Cash Internet Business System Part 1--

No matter what your skill level, **it's completely possible to start killing your debt.** This blog post will enable ANYONE in the world to start making an extra side income from their own Internet Business.

Plus, it doesn't cost you a single penny to implement.

Note: I could easily add some “fluff” to this or turn it into a video and sell it for \$47 or more, but we know that people need to get out of debt NOW.

So, follow the advice in this manual, **print it out**, and consistently follow through with it. It will make a huge difference in your life.

I'm actually going to reveal one of the subject topics (“niches”) that I've used to make an extra income online...I won't give the exact site, but I do reveal the exact topic below. (It's the example.)

Why am I telling you this? Well...

While this particular small Internet Business is only partially completed, it's gotten ranked in Google for a few great keyword phrases with VERY little work and it has made me a **small, steady income on autopilot**.

If I had actually “followed through” with this particular Internet Business, I'd make a LOT more money...but I've decided that it's wiser to devote literally all of my time to helping you out with your own websites.

Note: I'll be upfront with you here and get the “elephant in the room” out of the way: we're hoping to help you earn money so that you decide to invest some of it with us to grow your online business. **It's a win/win. You make money, we make money.** I hope that's OK with you.

So, I want to be clear...the core lesson here is to FOCUS on this Internet Business model. Time and time again, people do NOT follow our specific instructions, and if they did, we'd have a LOT of wealthy students.

Just do it, and stick with it.

Understand you won't get results overnight. Or even in a week. Sometimes it'll even take a month or more to see your first dollar come in.

But, once it does, I guarantee you'll be hooked...just **STICK WITH IT**.
Okay?

If you understand that and embrace it, let's get started...

Our PLR Quick Cash Internet Business model is going to have you create your own blog with unique content. "Niche marketing," or creating a niche website to get traffic and then make money from that traffic, is quite possibly the most straight forward way to make money online.

Here are the literal steps that you follow...

Step 1.) Pick a topic and do keyword research.

Using a free keyword tool such as [WordTracker's Free Keyword Tool](#), pick a random topic to talk about on your blog (preferably one that remotely interests you) and find some keywords.

Take time to think about what kind of topics you'd be comfortable writing about. You're going to be spending a LOT of time on working on your site, so it has to be a topic that you're comfortable with.

Our rule of thumb is this: could you write several letters to a friend about the topic? (That's really all that blogging is.)

PLR Quick Cash Tip: The beautiful part about working with Private Label Rights (PLR) content is that the topics have already been researched and chosen for you. For example, the topics of all of the reports and content that we distribute in our Simple PLR Club have proven themselves to be incredibly profitable. Don't get "locked" into one topic...and remember, you can always **make multiple blogs to make more money.**

You will be working in this topic for a decent amount of time so you should choose something you really like... choosing mechanic topics, such as working on cars, if you have no interest in it, wouldn't be a very good idea. Boredom would take over too quickly and you would give up.

Not only that, but your audience would be able to pick up on your boredom and they wouldn't return for more content.

The good news is that there are literally an infinite amount of different keywords that you can choose to get started with your website. For this example, we're going to use the example of the parenting niche. So, type in parenting into the keyword tool. **Parenting is a VERY hot niche, getting more than 34,000 searches per month.**

Don't get worried about the term "niche." It simply means "topic." You can pick virtually any topic you want for your website...

Do you enjoy pets? Working on cars? Traveling to Las Vegas? Parenting? The possibilities are endless. **Nearly every topic will enable you to make money online...but some ARE more lucrative than others.**

If you want to determine how "lucrative" a keyword can be for you, you can use [this tool](#) to search for your topic. KeywordSpy reveals a rough estimate of how much people are paying for ads to appear in Google for that particular keyword, and gives you a rough (relative) value of how lucrative it could be.

Keep in mind though, if you want to choose a topic that has a high cost per click (so that you earn more when ads are clicked), that most of these more expensive clicks are typically in highly competitive topics.

That ultimately means it'll be a little (or a lot harder) to get search engines to rank your website well and send traffic to you. It's a trade off.

Some of the higher paying topics include debt, insurance, supplements for weight loss, most kinds of loans and credit cards...

Of course, (continuing with our "Parenting" topic example) when we're setting up our blog, we don't expect to rank highly for the "parenting" keyword directly. That is a very long-term goal that you can shoot for, but it's certainly not feasible immediately.

Instead, we're going to be shooting for "long tail" keywords, or parenting-related keywords that don't have quite as many searches as "parenting" itself.

Looking now, there are quite a few good ones...

Parenting tips
Teenage parenting
Parenting styles
Foster parenting
Parenting advice
Good parenting skills
Effective parenting

ALL of those would be excellent keyword phrases to target for your website. For this example, we're going to go after parenting tips.

Don't worry if you don't find a "good" niche the first time around that you don't think you can write about. **What is most important is that you can write several articles about the topic, and that there are several long tail keywords available.**

Why is it important that there are a lot of long tail keywords available?

You're going to be writing articles about each of those keywords, targeting that keyword. More information on that later. But, you're going to want to make sure you have PLENTY of topics to write about. For parenting, we have all of the topics we listed above, plus...

Tough love parenting
Spoiled teenagers parenting
Parenting toddler
Rules of good parenting
Parenting quotes
Parenting videos
Parenting plan

...and MANY more. I'm not going to list them all, but hopefully you get the point. Find a niche with plenty of various topics to write about.

CAVEAT: Don't get TOO locked up on this part. **Pick a topic, don't doubt yourself, then continue.** FOCUS, as the sooner you get started, the sooner you can start killing off your debt. Too many people get caught up on this step.

OK, let's move on...

Step 2.) Find a good name for your new blog.

OK, so you have that list of keywords from WordTracker open in front of you, right? What we're going to do is go to Blogger.com and create a blog. It's 100% free to do so, and from what I know, anyone in the world is eligible to make their own blog (please correct me if I'm wrong.)

We're going to base the name of our blog on the keyword that we've chosen to target. If you recall, that keyword is "parenting tips." So, ideally, we'd want the name of our blog to be:

<http://parentingtips.blogspot.com>
or
<http://parenting-tips.blogspot.com>

Chances are, those are probably taken. So, we can add a word at the front of it to make it unique:

<http://bestparentingtips.blogspot.com>
<http://best-parenting-tips.blogspot.com>
<http://goodparentingtips.blogspot.com>
<http://good-parenting-tips.blogspot.com>
<http://myparentingtips.blogspot.com>
<http://my-parenting-tips.blogspot.com>

...there are literally 1,000s of other variations you could go with, and most will probably be available. Pick one and go with it. Don't worry too much about it, and don't get hung up on it. All that is important is that it contains the keyword phrase in the proper order. If we were targeting a keyword phrase such as "good parenting skills," we'd want to aim for these blog names:

...Hopefully you get the idea. Don't get too locked up on the name. An exact keyword phrase match is the best, but do NOT get worried if it's not available. Just add a short word before or after the name as I show above, and try the dashed names.

Note: In our personal experience, it doesn't matter whether you have a dashed name such as <http://parenting-tips.blogspot.com> or a "regular" name such as <http://parentingtips.blogspot.com>. Google seems to rank both equally to us, although some folks would disagree with us. You'll be able to make money online either way, so don't get locked up. :-)

OK, so, let's move on to step 3...

Step 3.) Write content for your blog.

This is the part where most people will fail. It's so easy, it just requires consistent work and focus...yet so few people can truly "handle" it. You're going to need to spend between **15 and 20 minutes per day** posting new content to your blog.

(Yes, this system takes a little bit of work, but it's worth it. It WILL help you kill your debt.)

PLR Quick Cash Tip: Here's where the beauty of Private Label Rights content comes into play. All you need to do is purchase the PLR content, break it up into articles (just as you would write them) and then quickly re-write the sentences. It cuts down content creation time by **50% or more**.

If you can consistently focus on adding content to your blogs, making one keyword-optimized posting to it every day, you're going to attract the attention of the search engines, generate web site traffic, then be able to use that traffic to kill off your debt by using Google AdSense. We'll discuss that in just a bit, don't worry.

IMPORTANT CHALLENGE: I honestly guarantee you that you WILL see results and some cash flowing from your blog within 4 to 6 weeks if you

post to it almost daily and use the web traffic generation tips that I reveal later in this system. You **MUST** be persistent!

First, let's talk about what kind of content, specifically, you should be writing for your blog.

Once again, we go back to our keyword list... :-)

You're going to write an article, every day, revolving directly around one of the keywords that you found. Some of the keywords won't make sense...that's fine. You won't want to write about those. But, as mentioned above, there are several different articles you can create using the keywords above.

Each of your articles need to meet the following criteria:

- * the title should be the EXACT keyword phrase
- * your article should be between 300 and 700 words long and should contain the exact keyword between 3 and 4 times, depending on the length of your article
- * the exact keyword needs to appear in the first 50 words and the last 50 words of the article
- * should contain 100% useful information that visitors would appreciate reading and builds credibility

...that's all you need to do. Post one article, **every day** and you'll be able to start generating traffic and then you'll be able to make money online by monetizing the traffic. Of course, you need to get the ball rolling for the traffic to start flowing though.

Step 4.) Build links and get traffic to your site

Once you've started to write several articles for your blog, it's time to start getting your site noticed by the world. **The way to do this is with high-quality, one-way backlinks.**

Many people get hung up on this part and think they need to buy backlinks, but you can get several backlinks for free. Here's just a few free methods. Feel free to "mix and match," you should use as many of them to link to

your site as often as possible for the best possible results.

PLR Quick Cash Tip: There's no reason you can't use your re-written private label rights content to post on some of the websites below. As long as you're providing useful advice, post as often as you can in as many places as you can...but, don't SPAM or post useless content.

1.) Go to Yahoo Answers, find 1-2 open questions related to your niche (use the “advanced” feature to search only for open questions) and post an answer. Use your website as a source for the information. Make sure your answers are high quality, not just cut and paste from your website.

If you do this once per day, you'll have a ton of great backlinks directly from a reputable site. Plus, it takes only a couple minutes at most to post an answer.

2.) Go to a related blog and post a highly relevant, high quality comment on one of the posts. Post good content and a good response to whatever blog post that you're commenting on, with a link back to your website.

Here's a tip: Most blogs are setup so you comment using your name, URL and then the comment itself. Often, your name becomes hyperlinked and goes back to your site. To make your link more “relevant” from Google's perspective, you should instead list your “name” as the name of your website.

So, for example, if we were commenting on a blog and our site was parentingtips.blogspot.com, then I would have “Parenting Tips” be my name. You'll want to change it up...sometimes you might want to use “Good Parenting Tips” as your name, for example. Just post using a bunch of different “names” that are actually keywords and you'll build plenty of highly relevant backlinks.

3.) Create a Squidoo lens and optimize it the same way you optimized your blog. Try to get your lens name to be <http://squidoo.com/parentingtips> or <http://squidoo.com/parenting-tips/>, for example. Put a bit of content on the lens, which you can steal from your own website. Just take an article or two from your website (or use your

PLR content), re-write it a bit and then put it on the lens and link back to your site.

4.) Create another free blog on WordPress.com and point it back to your own site. You only need a couple high quality posts and then have them point back to your main website.

5.) Submit articles to our 3 main article directories: EzineArticles, GoArticles and SearchWarp. They should be keyword optimized, just like the posts you did for your blog. You can write about the same topics, but the articles do need to be unique. You should use the author bio box to point to your website.

6.) Post your articles on Digg.com. Even if you don't get many Diggings for your articles, linking to your site from Digg helps increase your link popularity.

7.) Submit your website to DMOZ.org. It will take a while to get listed, but it's a very strong backlink to your website. Note: your site must be high quality for them to accept it.

8.) Create a press release for your blog. Using a press release service such as PRweb.com, you can submit a press release to all of the search engines for only \$19. (Note: We are not affiliated with PRweb and don't make any money when you submit a press release. It's just worked out really well for us.)

This has gotten us a lot of high quality backlinks, but does cost a little bit of money. You can also submit a press release to many free press release sites.

9.) Use StumbleUpon to stumble your blog. It will help increase link popularity a bit, and also give you some direct visitors.

There are literally 100s of other ways to build links to your site, but the ones above are some of the easiest and most popular ways. After you get several backlinks, your site will slowly start to get indexed and appear in Google. After 30 to 60 days, you should start to see consistent, growing traffic to your website.

To track how much traffic you have, use a free service such as StatCounter or Google Analytics and paste the code into your blog. This is easy to do by going into the blog's editor. Don't be intimidated by the code. Scroll down to the bottom of the editor's page and paste in the code that StatCounter provides you. Then, you'll be able to see how many visitors you're getting and from what places!

OK, so, you have a solid, established blog that you post to as often as you can. What's next?...

Making the money!

Step 5.) Make money online by using Google AdSense.

Using Blogger, it's extremely easy to put Google AdSense into your blog. That will be your primary way to make money (and start killing your debt) after launching your blog.

Depending on the topic you've chosen for your blog, you'll start making anywhere from a few pennies to a dollar or two per click. With a site with high traffic, it can add up and bring you a nice side income...

You'll be able to earn anywhere from a few dollars per month to a few hundred. And, the amount will grow as your traffic grows.

It's a very powerful cycle.

Note: Do NOT click on the ads yourself...Google will ban you.

You'll want to add your Google AdSense "ad blocks" in 3 primary places on your website:

- 1.) The top of the blog (below the title, but above your blog postings.)
- 2.) The sidebar of your blog (below the "About Me" section.)
- 3.) At the end of your postings. (You should set it to one posting per page.)

By doing so, you'll maximize the amount of clickthroughs that you'll receive

from people visiting your blog.

Here's the best part about your blog, though...

As you continue to create new blog postings overtime, your blog will continue to grow. You'll get more visitors and they will click on your ads more often. It only takes a few visitors to make your Internet Business pump out cash for you.

...

If you follow this step-by-step checklist, you WILL kill your debt. You cannot fail. The most important part is that you keep posting to your blog and continuously build traffic and get more backlinks. If you make a few posts on your blog and give up because you're not seeing results, you will waste your time.

If you have extra time on your hands, spend your extra time by creating an extra blog post or by spending time creating more links to your website. If you do that instead of trying to manage 2-3 (or more!) blogs at once, you'll see MUCH better results.

And, all of your efforts will build on each other.

Beating your debt and creating your PLR Quick Cash Internet Business is just a matter of pressing on when you're discouraged. You're constantly going to be facing an uphill battle...some people give up after 3 or 4 weeks and no money in their pocket, but others hold out and keep following the instructions above...then the money starts pouring in.

It truly is a "no-fail" system. It takes work, but anyone willing to put the time in WILL succeed.

--PLR Quick Cash System Part 2 (Technical Help)--

To get started, go to Blogger.com. This is the one the easiest places to make a blog and make money off it. When you get to Blogger, you will see a place to sign in and a place to click if you don't have an account. If you have an email address through Google (gmail), you can use your email log-in info. If you don't, you can get started by clicking CREATE A BLOG.




In case you don't have a Google account already, I'm going to go ahead and assume you will click Create A Blog to get started. You need to fill out the information on the page - it asks for your email address, your name, and what you want your password to be. Make sure you agree to the terms of service too!

Once you have filled in your information, accepted their terms of service, and clicked to continue, you will see the following screen. Here is where you are going to pick the name of your blog.

You want to put some thought into the name because this will determine the link people will use to get to your new site. Read Part 1 of this manual to find naming strategies.

First, you are going to put a title in, then select a blog address.

For example: if you want a blog about dog names, you might want to name it “How To Name Your Dog.” You would put this in the blog title field without the quotes. Next you would put howtonameyourdog in the blog address field so that your web address will be <http://howtonameyourdog.blogspot.com>



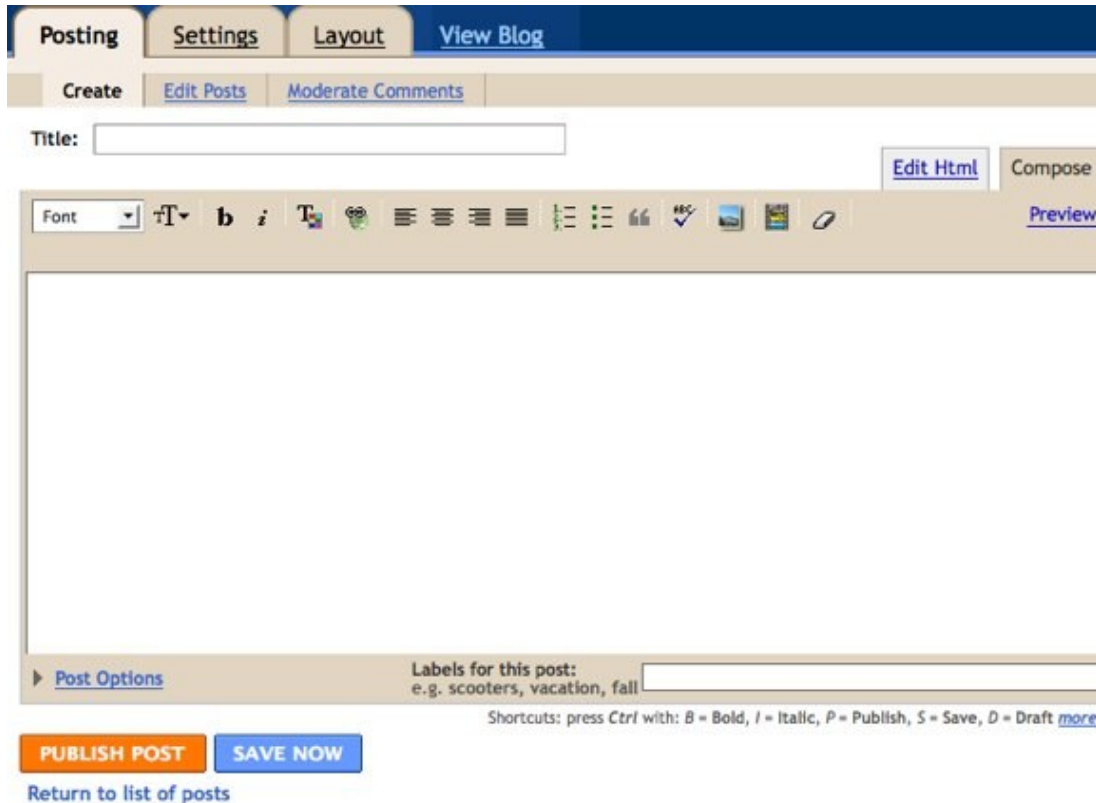

Once you have filled in all of the information on this page, click CONTINUE. The site will not let you move forward if the URL you have chosen has already been chosen by someone else, so you have to choose something unique.

On the next page, you get to choose your template. This is how your blog will look. You can always change it later, but choose something you like and can live with, at least for now. There are 12 different templates to choose from. Just click on the template you like and the little button next to it will be filled in, when you've selected it.

Once you have chosen a template, click CONTINUE again. The next page confirms the creation of your blog, so you can then choose START BLOGGING to continue.

After you have completed making your blog, you'll be taken to a page to make your first blog post. The following screen shot is what you will see. I'll explain each element further down.



Title: What do you want your post to be called? Put the name here. Your first post title might be called: “Top 10 Pet Names.” Remember, these titles should be **directly based** on the keywords you found using [WordTracker’s keyword tool](#).

Labels for this post: Here you can put common topics of the post. These labels distinguish when your blog will show up in search results. Labels for your first post could be: “Top 10 pet names, dog names, cat names”...and more. Look at related keywords from your keyword list to find good labels.

Publish Post: This will make the post live, so anyone who goes to your

website can see it.

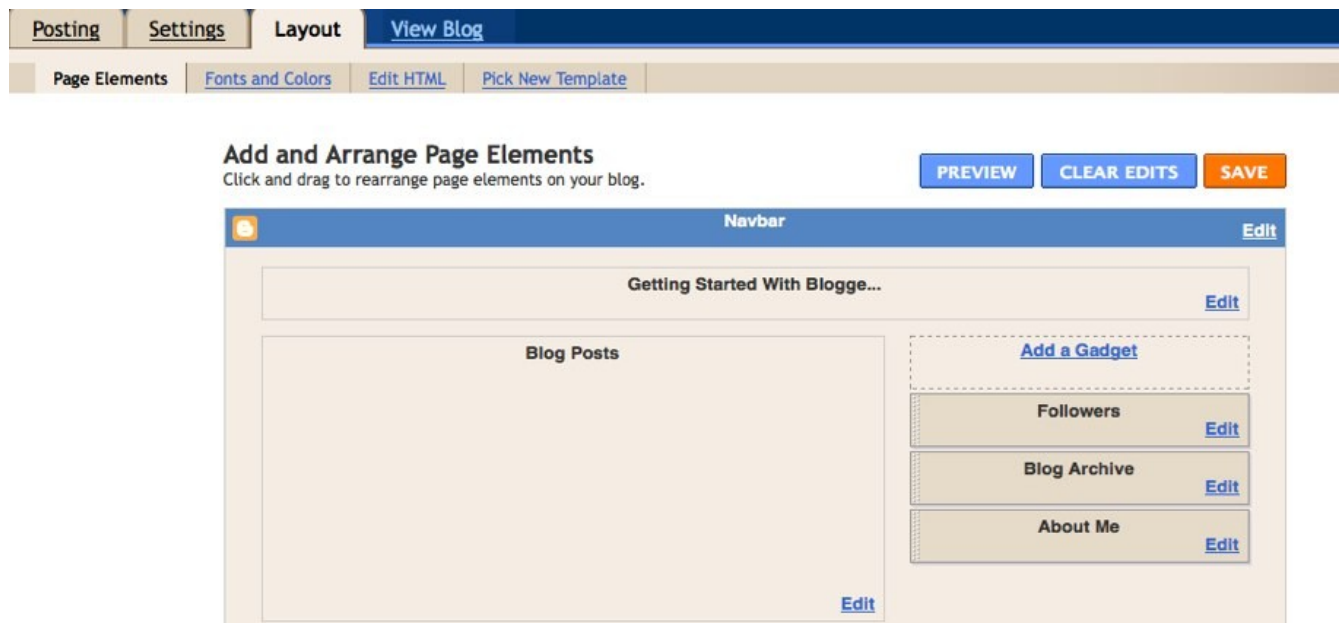
Save Now: This will save the post so that you can work on it later, then publish it when you are ready.

After you are done writing your post, just select **PUBLISH POST** to continue. Next you see that your post has been published on your site, and you can make more posts or view your blog.

As I said before, to make money off your blog, you will be using AdSense. AdSense is a program that lists ads on your blog. You make money when people click on the ads posted on your blog. Once your account is up to \$100, AdSense will send you a check.

The best part about AdSense is that it works completely on autopilot. You don't need to request a check. Once your account reaches the \$100 threshold (at some point this will happen every single month!) you'll be sent a check.

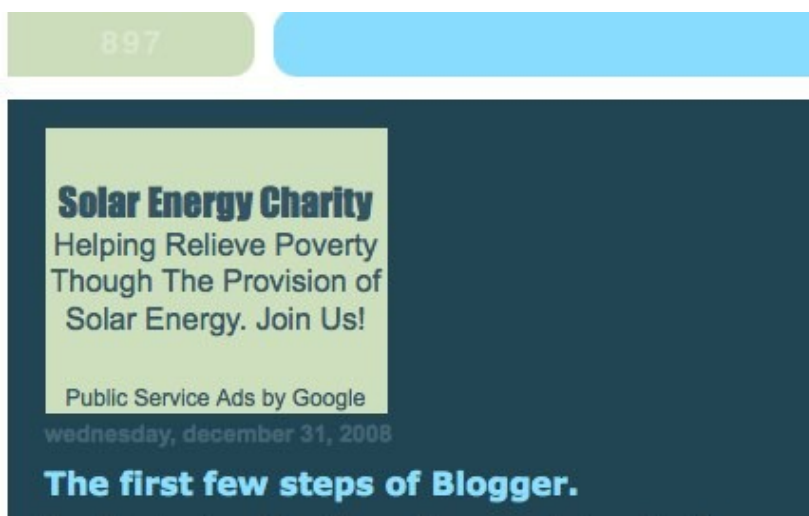
To add AdSense to your blog, you need to be signed into Blogger. Click on the **Layout** Tab on the top of the screen. You will see the following screen shot. This is the layout of your site, where you can move things in your sidebar.



Right now, you automatically have Followers, Blog Archives, and About Me

gadgets in your sidebar. Gadgets are just the sections of your site that do different things. In this case, they appear in the sidebar.

You can move these gadgets around on the site. You click on the gadget and while holding down the mouse button, move your mouse where you want the gadget to move. At first this might be awkward for you, but you will get the hang of it. This is called dragging the gadget. When you have it where you want, let go of the mouse button. This is a drop.



To use AdSense, all you need is to click Add a Gadget. A pop up should come up (if it doesn't, turn off your pop up blocker). You'll now go through the list of gadgets that come up and click on the plus sign by the AdSense gadget. This will add AdSense on your page.

It will ask if you want to use an existing AdSense account or create a new AdSense account. If you've already created an AdSense account, great! If not, which you probably haven't, select the option to create a new AdSense account. A pop-up will then appear asking for your email address, your blog language, and your email language. Click Create Account once you've answered the questions.

The next page asks you to check your email for a confirmation. This will confirm you do actually want to open an AdSense account. You can continue through this page. It just wants to let you know that you can start placing ads. To start off, AdSense inserts public service ads on your page until you have confirmed that email address. This means you won't make money until you click through the link in your email from AdSense.

It shouldn't take too long to get the e-mail from AdSense and you can quickly verify your account. Once you have done this, you will have AdSense on your blog and you can start making money!

While you can put the AdSense widget on the sidebar of the blog, most success with the ads comes from them being posted on top of the content, at the top of the page. See the image below for the proper placement.



You can (and should) also add AdSense in after the blog posts and above the sidebar. **Debt Killing Note:** Typically, left sidebars get more clicks than right sidebars.

Choose a New Theme

If you decide you don't like the theme of your page or you want one that has the sidebar on the left, it's super easy. Make sure you're logged into Blogger.com. Choose layout from next to your blog on the opening page. Select the link that says Pick New Template and you will see the themes you chose from before.

If you choose one that makes your AdSense go to the right, you can go back into layout again and choose a different layout. Don't forget that drag and drop technique I covered with you earlier! This will come in handy.

Rules for AdSense

There are a few rules you have to follow when it comes to AdSense. These are the most important of the rules and if you don't follow them, you could lose your account and any money you've already made through them.

1. You can not have more than 3 ad sections from AdSense on any page of

your site.

2. You must NEVER click on your own ads.

3. Do not encourage or ask any visitors, in any way, to click on ads.

They have other rules that are more specific. Some of these rules include how you are not allowed to mix the ads in so that they look like the rest of your site to trick people into clicking on them. You can't make images that ask people to click on your ads, or try to play the system in any way.

If you follow the rules, your account should be just fine. If you don't, your account will get closed.

Your AdSense Earnings

At any time, you can log-in to the [AdSense website](#) to see how much you have made from your blog. There will be a total showing how much you have earned today and a drop down menu that will allow you to choose other days or even the amount of time since your last payment.

As for payments, AdSense will only pay you when you have reached your account threshold. For most accounts, this is \$100. It may take you over a month to reach that amount, but as you write more, you will get more visitors and you will make more money. It'll all add up, earning you more and more as time goes on.




